### **Background**

The Gallipoli Centenary Peace Campaign is an initiative to question the role of war, ask how we can prevent war and conflict in the future, and promote peace and understanding.

The group is hosting a debate in the Petersham Town Hall on 21 or 22 April 2015 to discuss the role of war and war remembrance in Australian society and is seeking in-kind assistance from Council for the use of the Petersham Town Hall.

It is proposed that the debate be a joint initiative with Council and as such, Council's name and logo would be used on any marketing material related to the event.
